

Video Consent & Eligibility

Videos must meet all of the following criteria to be eligible for consideration:

- Appropriate for family audiences and therefore not contain, depict or refer to any crude, vulgar, obscene, sexually explicit, disparaging, discriminatory, offensive, illegal or otherwise unsuitable language, activity or other content (as determined by the grant selection committee in its sole discretion).
- Not contain, depict or refer to any content that disparages or refers negatively to Leaders Education Foundation, the grant application process, or any other person or entity (as determined by the grant selection committee in its sole discretion).
- Not conflict with any of the Leaders Education Foundation's core values, or otherwise be objectionable to the Leaders Education Foundation (as determined by the grant selection committee in its sole discretion).
- Not contain any content that violates any law or any third party's rights (including privacy, personality and intellectual property rights, or copyrights).
 - Meet all guidelines and criteria imposed by YouTube and Facebook with respect to videos submitted to YouTube and Facebook.
 - This includes omitting any background music or noise that does not belong to the applicant. YouTube and or Facebook will silence that portion of a video and the submission will be invalid.
- Not promote, depict or refer to any commercial enterprises other than Leaders Education Foundation and/or the applying school system.

In the event of a dispute, submissions shall be deemed to be submitted by the authorized account holder of the e-mail address associated with the entry (the "Applicant").

If a video shows any individual in such a way that the individual can be recognized, you must obtain written consent from that individual to permit Leaders Education Foundation to copy, display, transmit and otherwise use the video, and you must provide the Leaders Education Foundation the original copy of that consent upon Leaders Education Foundation's request.

The Leaders Education Foundation will not be responsible for any lost, delayed, misdirected, illegible, incomplete, damaged or undeliverable application entries, or any delay or failure to transmit, process, receive or consider entries.
